Abstract

Equality is a word that recurs in the European Union Treaties and a value pursued and supported by the actions and programs of the European institutions, which promote equal opportunities for all European citizens.

equal opportunities should translate into equality in active citizenship, community engagement and participation in the democratic processes of the Union.

Despite the efforts made, inequalities between population groups are still present in all European countries.

These phenomena present at the national level have impacts in local communities that are in closest contact with citizens and play an important role in fostering diversity, gender equality and inclusion For these reasons, the SEQUEL project has the main objective to support the role of European local realities, in promoting equality in citizens' participation to EU democratic processes.

The project create a network of 7 public authorities and NGOs coming from 5 different Eu contries (Italy, France, Germany, Romania and Poland) which will realize awareness raising campaigns, at local level, about the rights for everyone to play a stronger role in decision making process, 5 transnational events (one in each counrty) and a final on-line event to inform people about Eu citizenship rights (starting from Maastricht Treaty) and EU institutions decision -making and discuss about different declinations of inequality (gender inequalities, inequalities for people with migrant backgroud, inequalities among young people..), exchange best practices for equality developed at local level, create strong connection between citizens, local politicians and representatives of NGOs.

The project will involve more or less 450 direct participants

All the feedback collected in the transnational events will be included in a "Local plan for equality", a sort of guidelines that will help European local communities to promote equality for all in their policy and reinforce civic active participation of all citizens.
